This is a trip sponsored by the Cary Page Rotary Club, and our exchange club is the Osterakers Club in Akersberga, Sweden just north of Stockholm. At present we have 7 members of our club who have purchased airline tickets and provided deposits for the trip. Unfortunately, another couple had planned to participate, but were forced to drop out last week due to an injury. We would very much like to fill their spots in our group as reservations have already been made for a 2 picht Paltic cruice to Tallian. Estenia, and a charter bus days trip to the Rotary Peace Center at the University of Uppsala in Uppsala, Sweden. It is our hope that the participants in this year's exchange will host Swedish Rotarians and spouses next year. However, it is not a requirement for participation.

I'm attaching a preliminary itinerary and budget for our week-long event. Host families in Akersberga have already been secured, and at present we have an empty spot for a couple. Everyone is expected to bear the cost of their own travel to/from Stockholm (Arlanda Airport) as well as ground transportation to the Radisson Blu Waterfront Hotel in downtown, Stockholm and a one-night hotel stay there. I participated in a similar exchange to Sweden sponsored by District 7710 in 2015, and it was an absolutely wonderful experience. We formed life-long friendships on that tour and I expect we will this year as well.
