Interact Connection

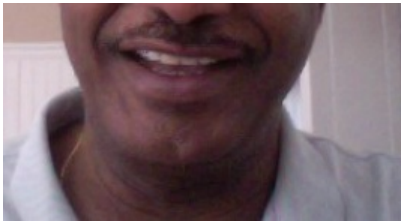

RCOR President's 7-Day Forecast

Warmer temperatures and muggier conditions will kick off the work week. High temperatures will be in the upper 80s each day this week with a chance of afternoon showers today through Thursday. A more humid airmass means overnight lows will remain in the upper 60s most of the week. For Tuesday and Wednesday night, temperatures will struggle to drop much lower than 70F. A drier air mass will move into the area later this week, making for a clear and drier Friday and Saturday.
