RCOR President's 7-Day Forecast

Get ready for a hot and dry week. Each day, temperatures will steadily climb further into the 90s. Sunday afternoon looks to be the warmest with high temperatures in the mid-upper 90s. Low humidity will allow for overnight lows to drop into the mid-upper 60s until Sunday night when more humid air moves into the area. You'll also need to water those outdoor plants this week as no rain is expected until early next week. For weather news outside of central NC, it looks like the tropics are starting to become active. A few weeks ago we had NWS Raleigh MIC, Jonathan Blaes, come speak to the club. He discussed how this year's tropical season is gearing up to be more active. Currently, Potential Tropical Cyclone 1 is developing in the southern Gulf of Mexico and there's a 10% chance that an area of storms in the southwestern Atlantic may develop into a tropical storm. Those traveling to coastal locations should keep an eye on the weather!
