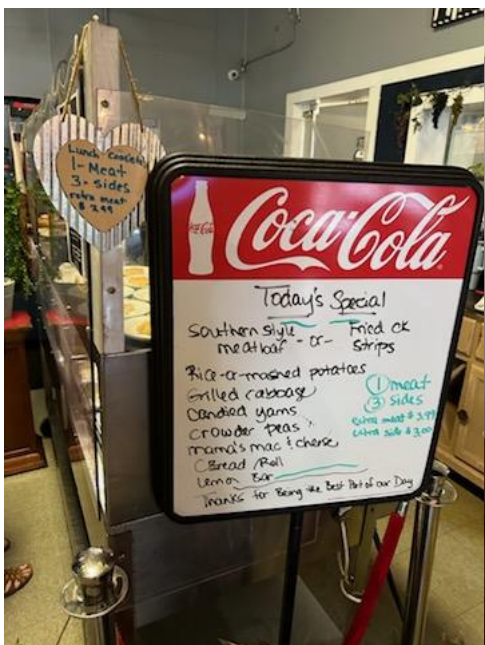

RCOR 7-Day Forecast

We're kicking off the work week with a Flood Watch in effect through 8AM Tuesday morning plus windy conditions this afternoon and evening. Total rainfall through 8AM Tuesday of 2-4" is expected with some areas seeing up to 6". A low pressure system that formed yesterday off the coast of GA/SC will move to the northwest and cross central NC today. Periods of light to moderate rain will be possible through mid-afternoon before strong showers and storms move over the Piedmont starting during this afternoon's commute home. These stronger showers and storms will continue tonight before moving out of the area early Tuesday morning. In addition to heavy rain, windy conditions will also be possible later this afternoon. Be on the lookout for the issuance of a Wind Advisory, which will indicate that 40+mph wind gusts are expected for our area. Wind gusts of that magnitude are capable of bringing down smaller or damaged trees, causing power outages, and blowing around unsecured objects outdoors. The strongest winds look to move across Wake County sometime between 4pm-10pm.

After today's unsettled weather, some storms will linger into Tuesday with high temperatures in the upper 70's to low 80s. This pattern will continue through the rest of the week with afternoon showers or storms possible each day. High temperatures each day are expected to hover around 80F with low temperatures in the mid 60s.
