Speaker Topic: The Fight for Women's Suffrage

Speaker Bio: Brenda taught in community colleges and at NC State while pursuing advanced degrees. She worked in institutional research, planning, and accreditation at NC State University (1983-1987), NC Central University (1987-1993), Durham Technical Community College (1993-1997), and the NC Community College System Office (1997-2001) where she served as Vice President for Administration. After retiring in 2001, she worked part-time at Durham Technical Community College, the UNC General Administration, and NC State University. She served on the Commission of Colleges at the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. She was president of the Southern Association of Institutional Research (SAIR) and active in the state, regional and national associations of institutional research and active in other professional organizations. Brenda grew up in Buncombe County, married Weaver Rogers, Jr., and lived and worked in Fayetteville, Jacksonville, Raleigh, and Durham.
