Evans has 22 yrs experience in medical device and healthcare sales. She currently represents the first and only FDA-approved blood test called Shield, which is FDA-approved to screen for colorectal cancer in a simple blood draw.

The Shield Blood test is currently available at no out-of-pocket cost to anyone with Medicare, VA or TRICARE. Shield is indicated for primary screening of colorectal cancer in people 45 to 85 years old who are at average risk.
