Professor at UNC Wilmington in 1982 and has taught and done research there in the areas of biological oceanography and limnology (the study of freshwater ecosystems) since then. He is currently Professor of Biology and Marine Biology at UNCW. He also serves on the Boards of Directors for Cape Fear River Watch and The Coastal Society. Dr Cahoon will be sharing his perspective on high tide flooding in our coastal community.
