Darlana Moore - scholarship nonprofit for children aging out of foster care

Darlana Moore

Ms Moore will talk about the scholarship nonprofit she founded for children aging out of foster care.



Darlana Moore is president of Gilbert Scholarship, Inc, which helps youth aging out of the foster care system obtain a college degree. Moore, a former foster youth, created the scholarship in honor of her own foster parents, Richard and Mary Gilbert of Asheville, NC. The scholarship is need based and awarded yearly to a student/students who have spent time in foster care.

The Gilbert Scholarship, Inc. is a 501c3 non-profit dedicated to providing college funding for youth aging out of the foster care system. Scholarships are \$1500 each. This non-profit is located in Wilmington, NC. and currently serves students at Cape Fear Community College in Wilmington and Wake Technical Community College in Raleigh. The objective for this non-profit is to add as many scholarships and colleges as is possible for youth from foster care, by growing financially through donations and grants.

The President of Gilbert Scholarship, Inc., Darlana Moore, aged out of the foster care system and named this scholarship in honor of her own foster parents, Richard and Mary
