

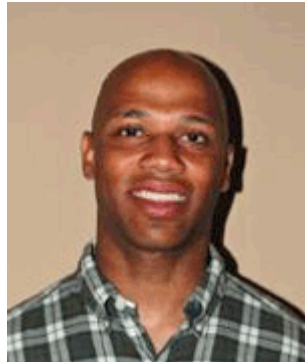

On behalf of Brunswick Family Assistance Agency (BFA), I would like to say, "THANK YOU", for your generous contribution of \$1,000 and supplies for our Summer Food program!!

With support from individuals like you, BFA is addressing the hunger crisis in our community. BFA is on the front lines of the local response to hunger in Brunswick County, and last year distributed over 300,000 pounds of shelf-stable, frozen and fresh foods to 22,379 individuals in our community. Our Summer Food program is a \$40,000 program which provided 1,241 food-insecure children in Brunswick County with 6,517 lbs. of food, in 2022.

So many of our neighbors are struggling to meet basic needs, and facing hunger on a daily basis. We are so grateful for your partnership in helping neighbors in need to access food. Your food donations make a real difference in the lives of hungry families, and help them gather around their tables for a wholesome meal.

We truly could not serve our community without people just like all of you! Again, THANK YOU, for all that you do to support BFA and our mission of helping those in need!

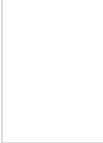
