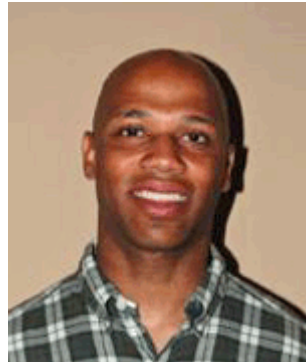

SBI Welcomes Debbie Smith, Ocean Isle Beach Mayor

Debbie Sloane Smith's parents moved to Ocean Isle Beach in 1955 when there was only a ferry to the island. They began Sloane Realty, a real estate and vacation rental company and the Ocean Isle Motel. After attending UNC Chapel Hill, Debbie returned to Ocean Isle Beach in 1972 and began her career. She is a graduate of the North Carolina Realtors Institute. Today, Debbie and her brother, Tripp Sloane, co-own and operate Sloane Realty Vacations, Coldwell Banker Sloane Realty, Ocean Isle Inn and Jinks Creek Waterfront Grille.

In 1983, Debbie was elected as a Town Commissioner for the town of Ocean Isle Beach, NC. Debbie served for 18 years as a town commissioner. In 2003, Debbie was elected Mayor of Ocean Isle Beach and continues to serve as Mayor. Debbie has devoted much of her mayoral reign to coastal preservation. She has been instrumental in the lobbying and legalization of terminal groins in NC and has served on Past Chair of NC Beach, Inlet and Waterway Association and currently serves on the NC Coastal Resources Advisory Council. She continues to advocate for shoreline protection and preservation that drives our economy in Brunswick County.

Debbie has also been actively involved in her community serving as:

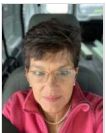
