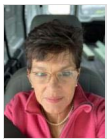

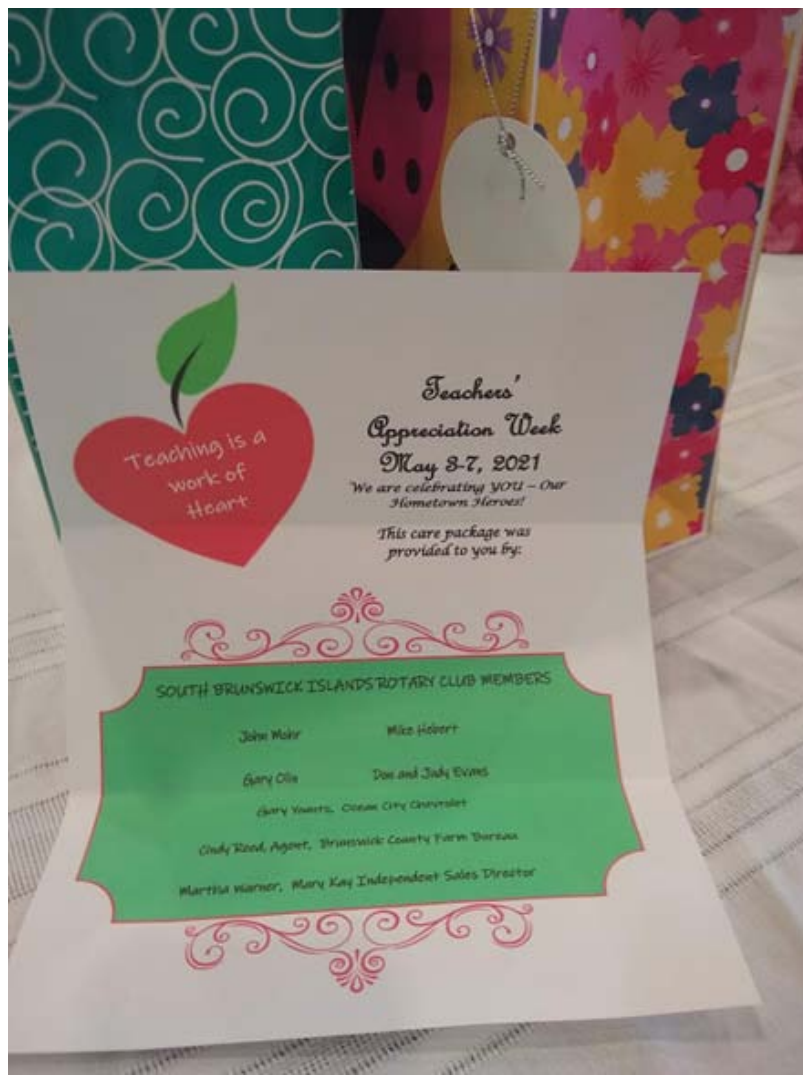

Way to go Aunt Irene's team!



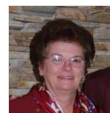
