He returned to the Beacon in May 2017 as the paper ♦s sports editor, a job Hickman dreamed about securing since his days at West Brunswick High School. He loved his sports job, but when the editor ♦s position came available a month ago, Hickman simply couldn ♦t pass up the opportunity to lead the newsroom of the paper he grew up reading.

Hickman married his wife, Maggie, in December 2013 and they have two children, 2-year-old son Huck and 11-month-old daughter Winnie Sue. The couple ♦s first ♦child♦ is their now-5-year-old bulldog Heyward.

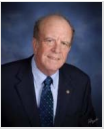
