She noted that she had gone to the Care Clinic to volunteer and was offered a job, which she took. Mrs Williams gave the club a Zoom tour of the Clinic as she explained a bit about the Care Clinic. The Care Clinic is a non-profit clinic that tries to serve the needs of low income members of the community with no health insurance including no Medicaid. The clinic was created between 1986 and August 1994 when it finally received its non-profit status. Aside from the Director and a couple of other employees, all clinical services are provided by volunteer physicians, Dentists, Chiropractors and Therapists. The clinic takes appointments by phone Monday – Thursday 9 AM to 2 PM for Tuesday and Thursday and 2nd and 4th Wednesdays from 5:30 to 8:30 PM during the week. Dental appointments are made Fridays (AM to 12 PM. Funding comes from donations, grants and what patients can pay. The clinic
