Health and Happiness: Happy Bucks were given by Janice McFadyen for her home repair, Joe Running for his and Maureen's anniversary yesterday, and Magda Baggett for the Rotaract Task Force headed by Nancy Barbie to learn about the need for Rotaract.

Club Program: PDG Dave Baggett introduced Patty Landy, who spoke about Better Health of Cumberland County. Better Health is a non-profit that provides free health services for individuals who do not have insurance or the money to pay for prescriptions, emergency Dental extractions, diabetes test materials and training courses, child obesity and weight control classes, dietary education, and hospital beds, wheel chairs, walkers, etc. Better Health provides two education clinics and screenings a week, training on how to draw blood for blood sugar tests. Patty said that most of the people Better Health sees have type 2 diabetes. She said it is believed that only half the people who have diabetes or who are pre-diabetic are aware of it. Most seeking help want to know what they can and should eat. To cover the cost, Better Health is funded by grants and donations, including from the United Way. Under current conditions anyone needing help can make an appointment by calling Patty at 910-491-8234.
