The Rotary Club of Morehead City-Noon met Tuesday, 1/31/23, at the Sanitary Restaurant!

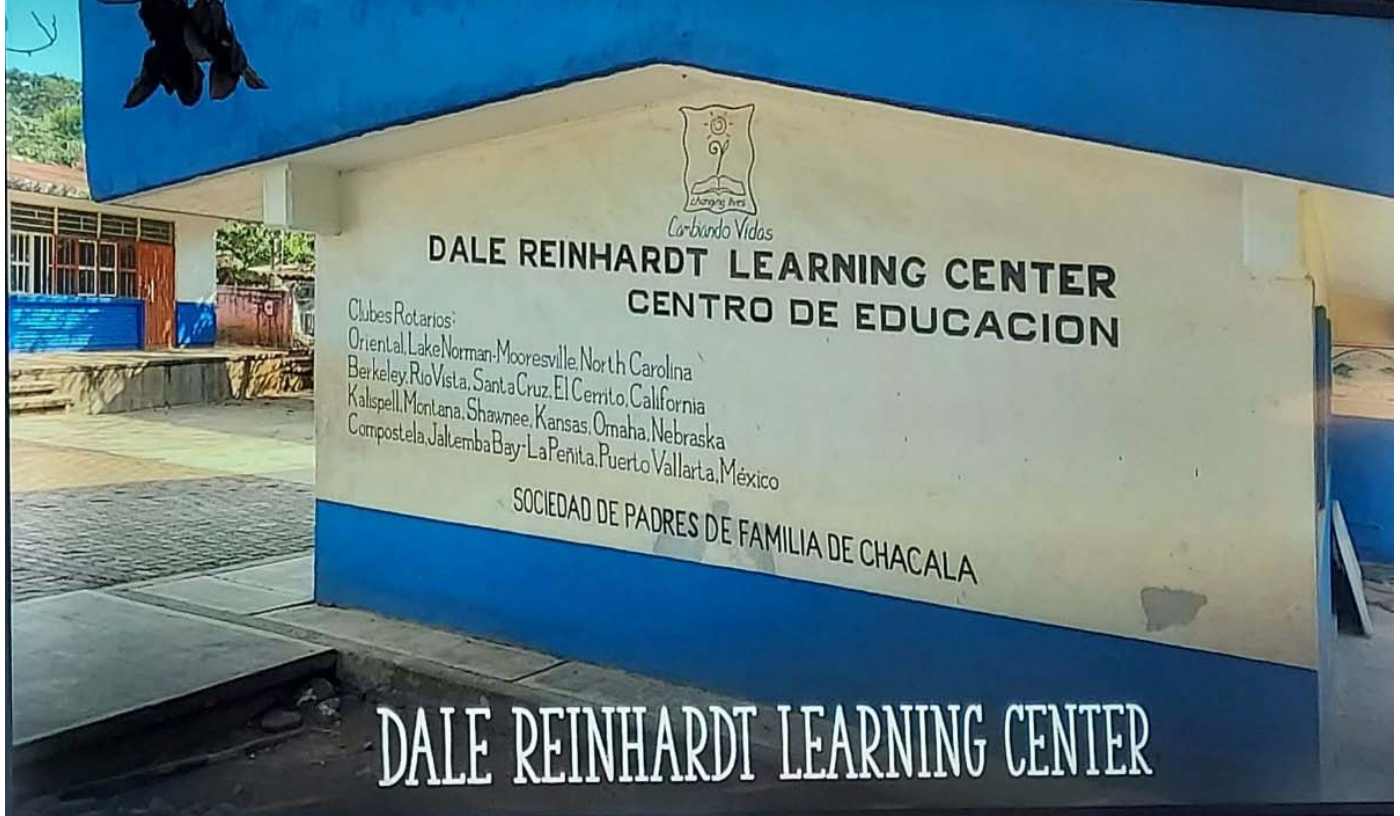
We returned to the Sanitary Restaurant and Penny served us but Shayna was out.
