We should think of other projects the club would like to do

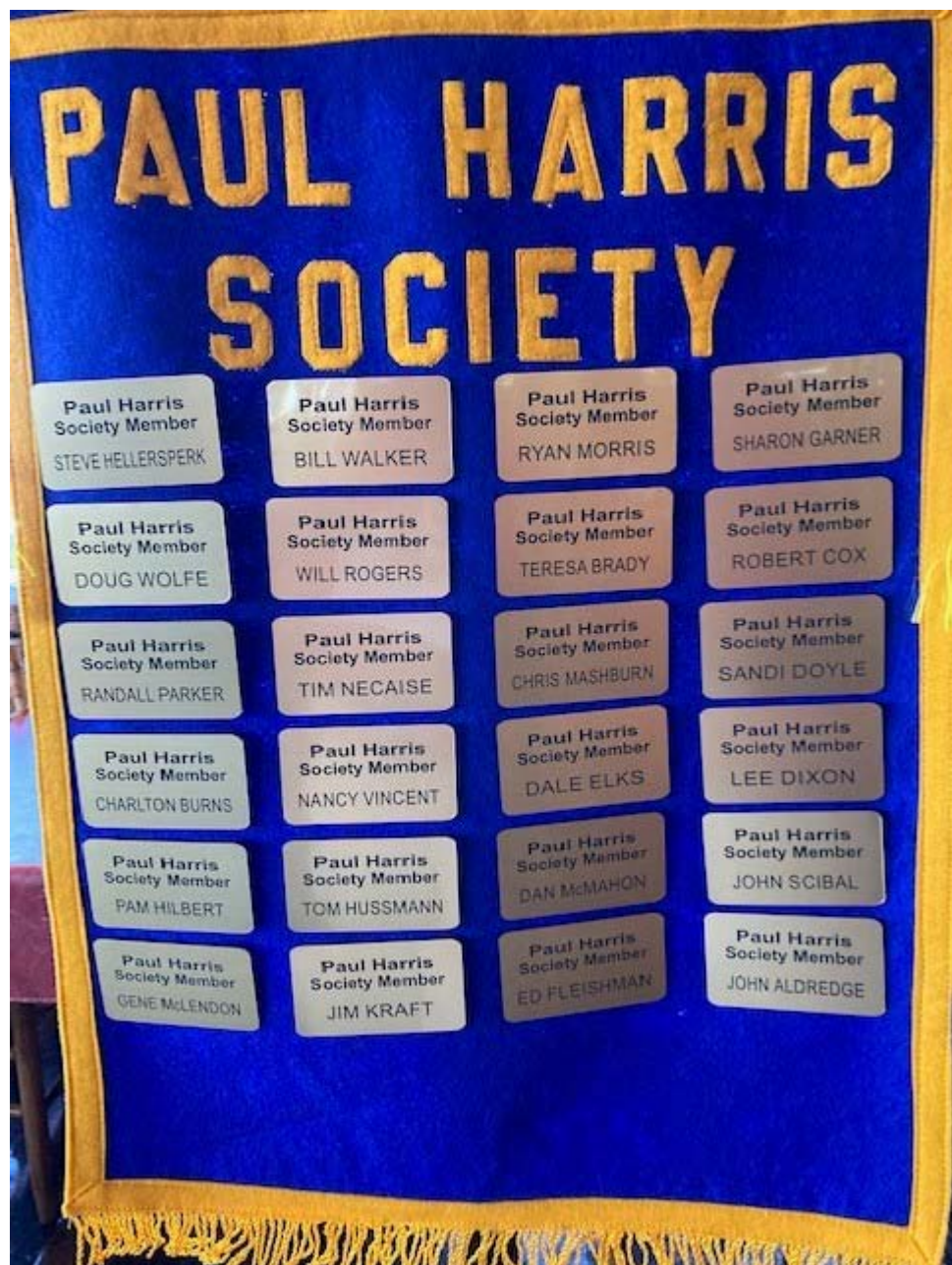
