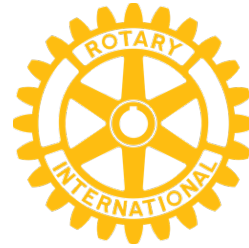

## Board of Directors Meeting July 2024 - Morehead City Noon

### Morehead City Noon Rotary Board of Directors Minutes July 8, 2024

The Noon Rotary Board of Directors met Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> at the Chamber of Commerce Conference room at 5:30 pm, Those attending were: President Tim Necaize, President Elect Pam Hillbert, President Elect Nominee Gary Lazorick, Secretary Diane Warrender, Treasurer John Aldredge, Board members Jane & Bob McClughan, Jill Droize and John Scibal.

Treasurer's Report by John Aldredge – Some of the notable figures were:

- Y/E 2024 Operating Bank Bal \$27,125.00
- Y/E 2024 Charitable Bank Bal \$43,182.00
- Approximately 1/3 2024-25 Dues Collected
- Y/E 2024 Fundraising Total \$29,164.00
- Y/E 2024 Grants Awarded \$31,135.00
- Happy Dollars for Match \$ 2,224.94
- Installation Banquet Exp 2024 - \$ 2,963.09

The finances of our Club are sound and no areas of concern.

President Tim is trying to complete the Board with new members. We discussed possible Rotarians he might approach to become a member of the 2024-2025 Board. Tim will get in touch with those suggested to see if they are interested.

Tim reviewed the dates for the upcoming Board meetings, as the Chamber had other conflicting schedules for several of our planned dates. September Board meetings will be the first **Tuesday** of the month on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, October will be the **second** Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup>, November will be **second** Monday, the 11<sup>th</sup> and December will be the first Monday. All meetings will be at 5:30 pm at the Chamber.

Tim announced the schedule for club programs are the Admin group for July, Public Image for August and Foundation committee for September.

Pam Hillbert said she would like to do several Micro programs during the next several months. One she wants to do on Tuesday, August 20<sup>th</sup> is for all to take part in packing back packs for children who will be starting school. She will set it up and advise Rotarians about needed items. Also, on Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup> we will pack boxes to aid people in Nassau that will be delivered by Carnival Cruise Line with the Rotary District Cruise in October. This is a shared project with eastern Rotary clubs and will be received by the Nassau Rotary Clubs for distribution. The club will receive the boxes needed for this project.

Gary Lazorick, Fundraiser Chair, reported he had talked with the local Golf Cart dealer for a delivery date. He hopes we can start selling tickets for the golf cart very soon. We can use a spot at the Beaufort Market that occurs each Saturday. We were very successful with sales there last year. Some Board members suggested other good spots for ticket sales. He hopes we can sell enough by the Seafood Festival to have paid for the cart.

John Scibal, Membership Chair, said the committee wants to again start the "Discover Rotary" evening socials for prospective new members. The goal for this Rotary year is to have a total of 70 members in the Noon club. Now, we have 66 members, plus Jane as our Honorary member for 67.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
