Our speaker for the day is Nancy Barbee, Director of the End Polio Now with the Rotary Foundation. There were no birthdays or club anniversaries for this week. Diane informed the members that Rotarian Ava Bryant had two deaths in her family this past week and to keep her in their thoughts. The club attendance for the day was 32.

Tim has added a new â€œpositive remarksâ€ item to the schedule each week. Diane Warrender was chosen for today. Diane remarked that she had lost a very dear friend on June 17<sup>th</sup>. Foundation Chair Chris Mashburn, was not in attendance, so Tim asked Tom Hussman to come forward. He was presented with his Paul Harris Foundation Pin Plus 1.

Pam Hilbert chair of the Service Projects committee said she wants to have an evening meeting on August 6<sup>th</sup> for her committee members to review applications for grants. She reminded Rotarians about the social celebration being held in Newport this evening at 5:30 pm at Shortway Brewery.



Doug Wolfe introduced our speaker Nancy Barbee, a Past District Governor, and now End Polio Now Director for the Foundation. She is originally from Maysville, NC. She has lead Rotary groups to India each year for polio inoculations since 2010, except for the COVID years. Nancy talked about the many clubs who have benefited from the Foundation funds. She said our club had received a \$25,000 grant during COVID to help feed children who were not in school and not able to receive daily meals. The Endowment Fund includes our own John T. Capps Endowment fund. The Noon Club set up this Endowment Fund for John after his passing. Each Rotarian can establish an Endowment by setting it up in their estate. Also, each club can donate to the "End Polio Now" fund an amount of \$1500 annually, and the total is matched at the end of the Rotary year by the Bill Gates Foundation. An individual member may be part of the Polio Plus Society by donating \$100. per year. The monies from the Foundation Annual Fund that they receive from Rotary Clubs are invested, and 50% comes back to the Districts. Other funds go to the World Global Fund, from which our international project in Mexico got a \$60,000 grant. Good information passed on by Nancy to our Club.





John Smith did Happy Dollars, and was able to collect many dollars for the fund.

Gary Lazorick was not the winner of the 50/50, so more money for next week.

President Tim adjourned the meeting until next Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>.
