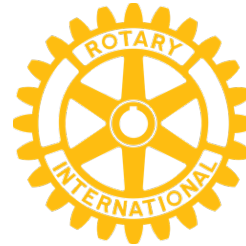

President Tim asked Rotarian Jim Kraft to come forward. Tim presented Jim with his Paul Harris Foundation pin Plus 3. Congratulations Jim!

Treasurer John Aldredge reminded the members that \$8,000. in dues are outstanding. Members can pay at a meeting or send to him at: 1909 Fisher St., MHC 28857.

Tim introduced our speaker, Kyle Marek, C.O. of Carteret Health Care. Kyle received his Bachelor of Science and Masters Degrees from East Carolina University and has worked with the hospital for 25 years. He was Vice-President of General Services and Chief Information officer. He is married and has a son who just graduated from ECU and a daughter who is a senior in high school. Carteret Health Care is a 135 bed hospital with approximately 1,200 employees. They average about 45 travel nurses working at the hospital, and also average about 40,000 emergency room entries per year. A \$27 million expansion of five new surgery rooms of 1,200 sq.ft. each, and the renovation of an entire wing for sterilization for pre-operations have been completed. The new Helicopter pad located at the Armory property has been completed and being used. The large renovation in the front of the hospital will add 35 parking places, along with the a new Radiology and Oncology Department. A second floor of that addition will be for meeting rooms. Estimated completion date is in about 16 months. Additionally, the hospital purchased in 2021, five acres of property in western Carteret, that has recently been cleared to build a 30,000 sq.ft. building, and add 5 new physicians to cover the western end of the county. As always, the hospital is seeking new physicians, and 2 new cardiologists are being considered. Good information about our health care facilities.
