# Morehead City Noon Board of Directors meeting September

## Noon Rotary Club Morehead City Board of Directors meeting Tuesday, September 3, 2024

The Noon Rotary Club Morehead City met Tuesday at 5:30 pm at the Chamber of Commerce Conference room. Those attending were Tim Necaie, President; Diane Warrender, Secretary; John Aldredge, Treasurer; Gary Lazorick, President Elect, Nominee; Board members: Teresa Brady, Robert Cox, Bob and Jane McClughan and Tom Hussman.

Absent: Sharon Garner, Bill Taylor, Pam Hilbert, Chris Mashburn and Jill Droze.

President Tim opened the meeting and asked for approval of the minutes of the August Board meeting. Gary made the motion and John seconded the motion.

John Aldredge gave the Treasurer's report. He pointed out there is \$2,958. in the Happy Dollar Fund. If needed, the club can use some of these funds for the Nassau boxes we will pack for the District Conventions cruise to Nassau in October. Additionally, the club received grant district funds of \$2500 distributed to be used for various grants.

As of this date, the club has made \$10,000 from ticket sales for the cart. This amount will cover the cost of the cart and other promotional costs. From this point, all money raised is profit for our future Service Projects. John commented about how successful the Beaufort Farmer's Market is for selling our cart tickets, lots of interested buyers.

There are approximately \$3900 in unpaid dues. Several are paying in installments.

Tim advised the programs for the rest of September have been arranged. Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>, Erica Jones from the Public School System; Sept. 17<sup>th</sup>, Packing boxes for Nassau project; Sept. 24<sup>th</sup>, New Member Induction and Gene Hicks from the Charlotte Club to talk about substance abuse. He also reminded members of the Club Social Deck Party on September 28<sup>th</sup>, hosted by Pam and Todd Hilbert at their home.

Jane McClughan discussed the planned Christmas shopping event for the children from the Boys and Girls Club. She hopes to be able to include other children in need.

Tim discussed the International Global Grant that we have been working on this year. Dale Elks is working with the Foundation to get more information about what parts of our requested grant can be covered. Brick and mortar cannot be included. We hope to get the 3 buses and supplies for three classrooms we had requested. More information to come soon.

Robert Cox said he wanted to discuss the problem, as he saw it, of not being able to hear some of the speakers clearly and other comments made by club members during question time and Happy Dollars. He said he felt this was a part of the meeting that has substance to all. Diane expressed her frustration of not being able to hear well from her location due to noise from the restaurant staff and club members sitting closer to the back talking among themselves during a program or other presentations. We discussed some ways to improve this problem. Robert also said he would like to have more information as a club about the Polio project and maybe we could have someone from the District to present a program soon.

There being no other business items, the meeting was adjourned.
