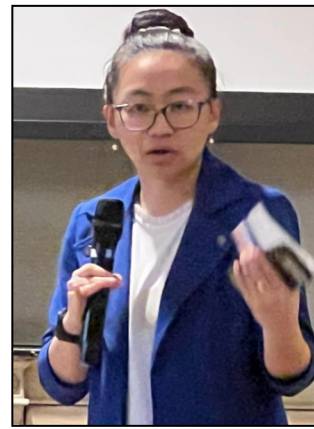

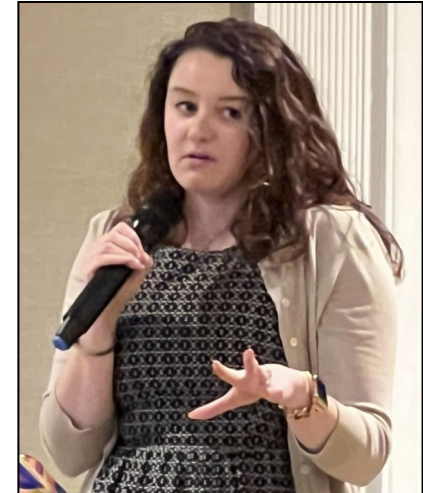

Sarah Daniel, Director of Economic Mobility Strategy at the United Way of the Piedmont, discussed case management and the success story of Thomas, who was living at Miracle Hill when he joined the program. Now he has graduated and has been hired full time with the county and has just been promoted to a supervisor. He has a car and a goal of reestablishing a relationship with his children. The biggest benefit of the program, says Daniels, is seeing the person change and evolve.



Marilyn Nguyen with the city of Spartanburg says the program began in July 2021. Participants are currently homeless and once accepted into the program have weekly case management meetings, weekly life skills classes, and work part time for 90 days. There have been 8 graduates since the program began.
