Diana Bramble, National Parks Superintendent, delivered our program last week. She provided an overview of the 4 national park properties in our area: Cowpens National Battlefield, Kings Mountain National Military Park, Ninety Six National Historic Site, and the Overmountain Victory National Historic Site. She talked about the 250th anniversary of the Revolutionary War, which really was a civil war that tore families apart. There was more fighting on lands in SC than any other place in the country. She reminded us that the parks are not just places for history, but also for recreation like birding and hiking. Goals for the Parks in our area include highlighting underrepresented stories of the Revolution and establishing Friends groups to help engage with the community.
