We enjoyed having students from Spartanburg School District 7 with us, who gave us a preview of The Music Man. Over 150 students, K-12th grade, are involved in the production.

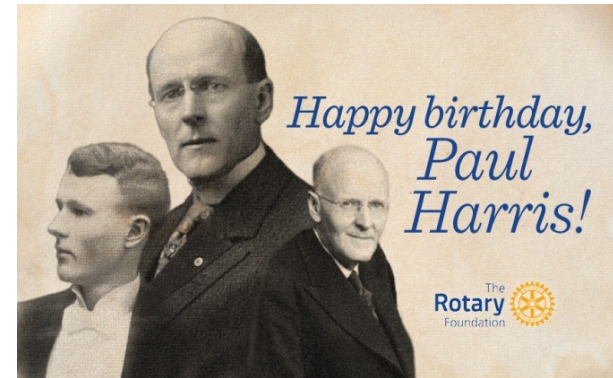
