Phil Feisal with Spartanburg Regional Health System told the Club that the US system is unique in the world, as we are the only market based healthcare system. In 1940 there was the expansion of health insurance through employer based programs. In 1954 the IRS determined that employee and employer contributions would not be taxed. The Hill-Burton act required hospitals to have 4 beds for every 1,000 citizens in the community. Spartanburg Regional is 5 hospitals strong, sees over 200,000 ER visits annually, has almost 10,000 employees and 700 physicians. Workforce development is their biggest challenge.
