Though he lost the Senate race to Stephen Douglas, the debates of 1858 propelled him to national prominence. "The eyes of the world were on America to see if this grand experiment will survive." John has 2 books on Lincoln: The Rail Splitter, which came out this year, and Old Abe, which garnered a call from a fellow Lincoln historian, Mike Pence, who said "this is the best book on Lincoln I've ever read."
