Speaker of the Week - Dr. Zach Marshall, Teach My People

Originally from Bristol, TN, **Dr. Zachary Marshall** serves as the Community Outreach Director for Teach My People, a role he began in March 2021. He moved to Georgetown in January 2021 as his wife, Jenni, became Associate Pastor at Georgetown Presbyterian Church. Prior to beginning work at Teach My People, he served as Director of Music for Wesley United Methodist at Frederica in Saint Simons, GA.

A classically trained opera singer, Zach has served on the music faculties at East Tennessee State University, Bethany College, Eastern Kentucky University and Kilgore College. He will teach classes at Horry-Georgetown Technical College this fall. Zach holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in voice performance from the University of South Carolina with a minor in music history. He also holds a Master of Music from the University of Tennessee and a Bachelor of Music from East Tennessee State University. Zach has taken performing student choirs to England, Czech Republic, Austria, and Costa Rica. His choirs have performed at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in New York City and several venues around London, England, including the Royal Festival Hall. He has performed many opera and oratorio works and frequently appears as a tenor soloist and recitalist. In addition to his work as a solo vocalist, Zach Marshall serves as a guest clinician for all-county and regional honor choir events. He is a member of Doc Bonhomie, an Americana style band based out of east Tennessee and holds memberships in National Association of Teachers of Singing, American Choral Directors Association, Pi Kappa Lambda, national music honor society, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia music fraternity. Zach has also competed internationally in the Barbershop Harmony Society. He is married to Rev. Dr. Jennifer Marshall and they have two children: Georgia, age 4 and Callum, age 9 months.
