Speaker of the Week - June Shea, Dragon Boat at the Beach

A nonprofit organization, Dragon Boat at the Beach, is made up of cancer survivors who practice ancient dragon boat racing to stay fit and stick together.

Dragon boat racing is an ancient Chinese sport that takes 20 paddlers in a 4x40ft boat with a coach and steersperson.

The nonprofit group formed in 2007 welcomes cancer survivors of all ages and stages of recovery.

June Shea, current president of Dragon Boat at the Beach, found the group after she came down with cancer, and the group has kept her going through hard times.

The group goes out on dragon boats three times a week for 10 months a year. There are three different types of paddles you can participate in. There is an endurance paddle to practice stamina, a leisure paddle to take in the scenery of the Marina and a race prep paddle.
