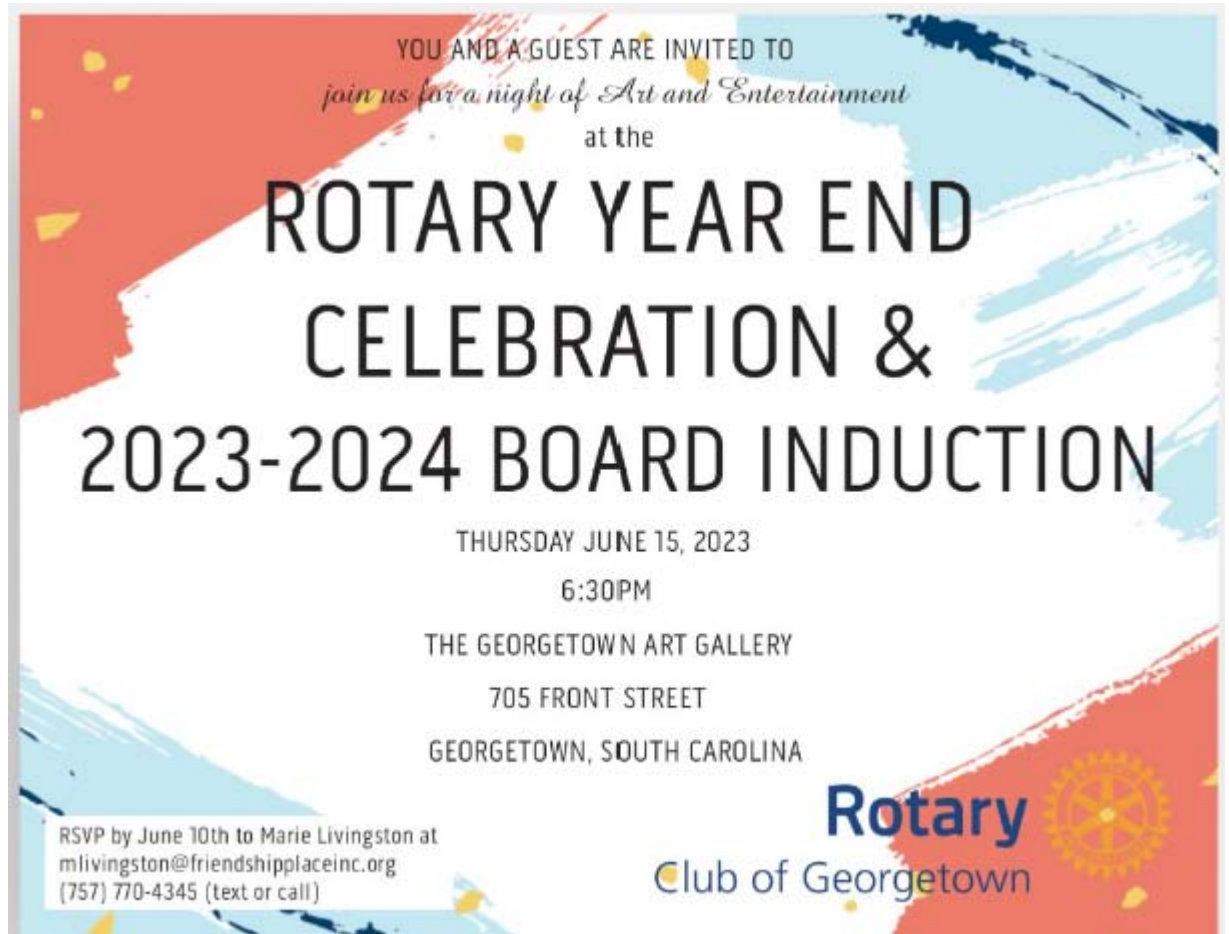

Speaker of the Week - Richard Almeida and Steven Sims

Richard Almeida is the John Monroe Johnson Holliday Professor of Political Science at Francis Marion University and the Co-Director of the Belle Baruch Institute for South Carolina Studies. A native of Woonsocket, RI, Rick received his BA from the University of Massachusetts – Amherst, his MA from the University of Memphis, and his Ph.D. from the University of Missouri – Columbia, all in Political Science. His main interests include US Presidential elections and interest groups and lobbying. Rick's recent work has appeared in Carolina Currents, International Social Science Review, and American Politics Review. Outside of work, he enjoys spending time with family, particularly traveling, cooking, and anything close to salt water.

Steven C. Sims is the Head of Access Services Librarian/Associate Professor in the James A. Rogers Library of Francis Marion University. He received his BBA from Francis Marion University and his MLIS from the University of South Carolina. Steven is active in many university organizations and committees, specifically among them FMU's Universities Studying Slavery Initiative, where he serves on the executive board and is a founding member/past president of the FMU African American Faculty and Staff Coalition. His recent appointments include Principal Investigator for the History of the Enslaved at Hobcaw Barony and chair-elect for the Betty Jean Windham Greer Endowed Chair in Library Science.
