-SECURITY GATE 1 (SOUTH GATE)- Let them know you are going to Arthur Hills.


-Continue onto Ocean Lane

- In 2007, the Hilton Head Island Rotary Club selected Alzheimer's Respite and Resource (later renamed Memory Matters) as a Club project to help provide a permanent home for the organization with a pledge of \$250,000. The Club raised \$14,475 during the first year and the project was chaired by Rotarian Dennis Nelson.

- In 2014, India was once thought to be one of the most challenging places to end polio. In 2014, India went three full years without a case of polio caused by the wild polio virus and the World Health Organization (WHO) South-East Asia region is certified polio-free. In Nigeria, sustained efforts to vaccinate children who previously could not be reached because of a lack of security in the country's northern states, finally resulted in that country reaching the three-year milestone. The WHO African region is certified wild polio virus-free in 2020.






