

Proceed to the Main Security check point on Queens Folly Road past Alexander's Restaurant and the tennis courts. Palmetto Dunes Security will confirm your name from our guest list and allow you to continue to the Veranda at Arthur Hills.

- Head south on Queens Folly Road towards Queens Grant
- At the traffic circle, take the first exit (Ocean Lane)
- SECURITY GATE 1 (SOUTH GATE)- Let them know you are going to Arthur Hills.**
- Continue onto Ocean Lane
- Turn Right onto Leamington Lane
- SECURITY GATE 2- Let them know the name of the event you are attending at Arthur Hills.**

5. Mason Petty from Heritage Academy


