Born on this date: In 1924, Arlene Dahl, an American actress (Journey to the Center of the Earth, Ambush, One Life to Live), TV panelist (What's My Line), and perfumer. She died in 2021.

Born on this date: In 1950, Steve Wozniak, an American pioneer of the personal computer revolution of the 1970s and co-founder of Apple Computer.

Died on this date: In 1919, Andrew Carnegie, a Scottish-American industrialist, steel tycoon, philanthropist and one of the richest Americans ever.

Died on this date: In 1956, Jackson Pollock, an abstract artist, who died in an auto accident.
