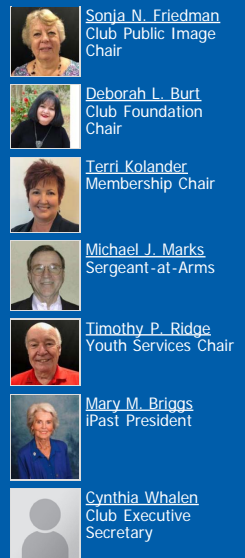
Invite Your Friends To Attend!

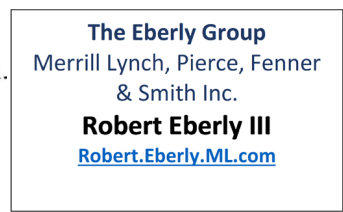
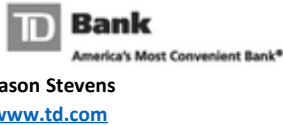
The Four-Way Test
