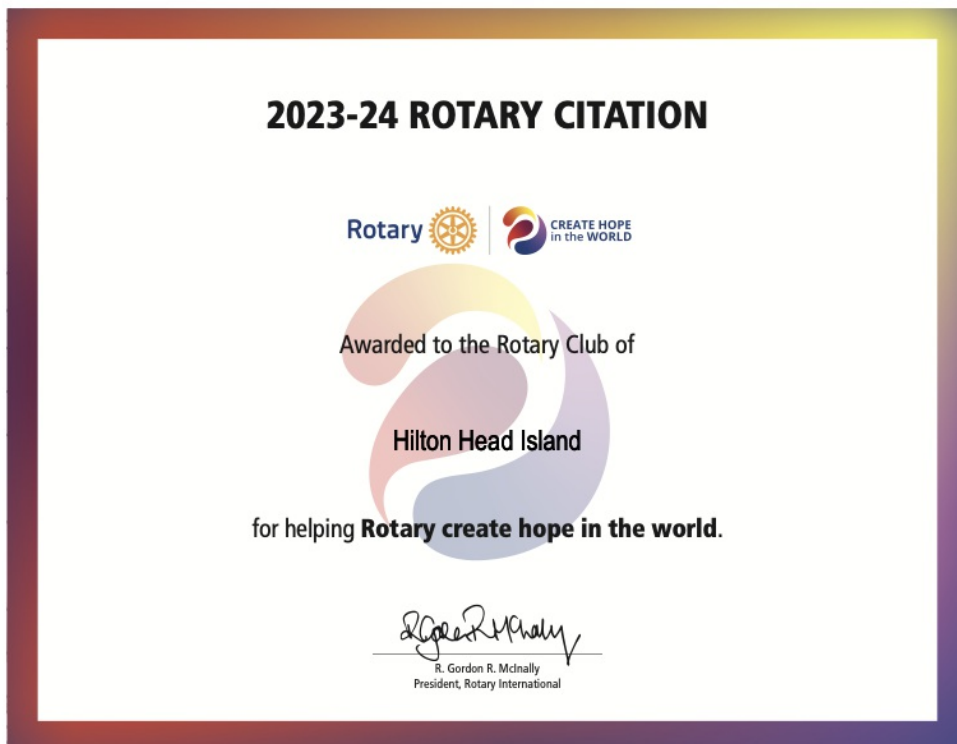

Did You Know?

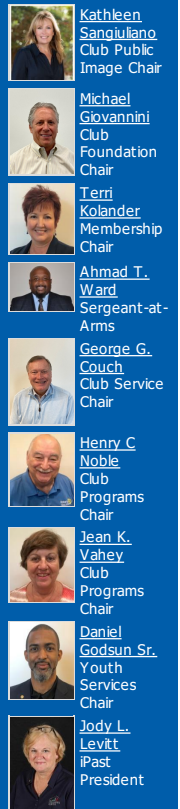
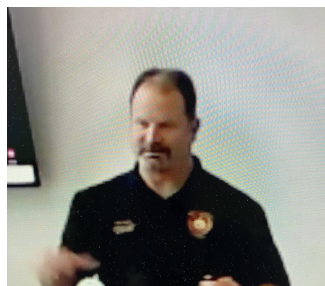

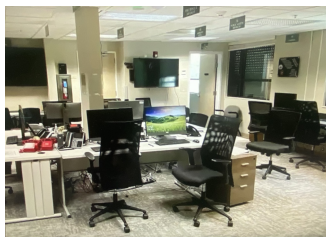
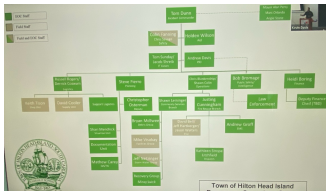
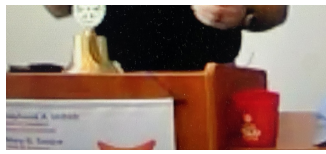
August 1, 2024 Meeting

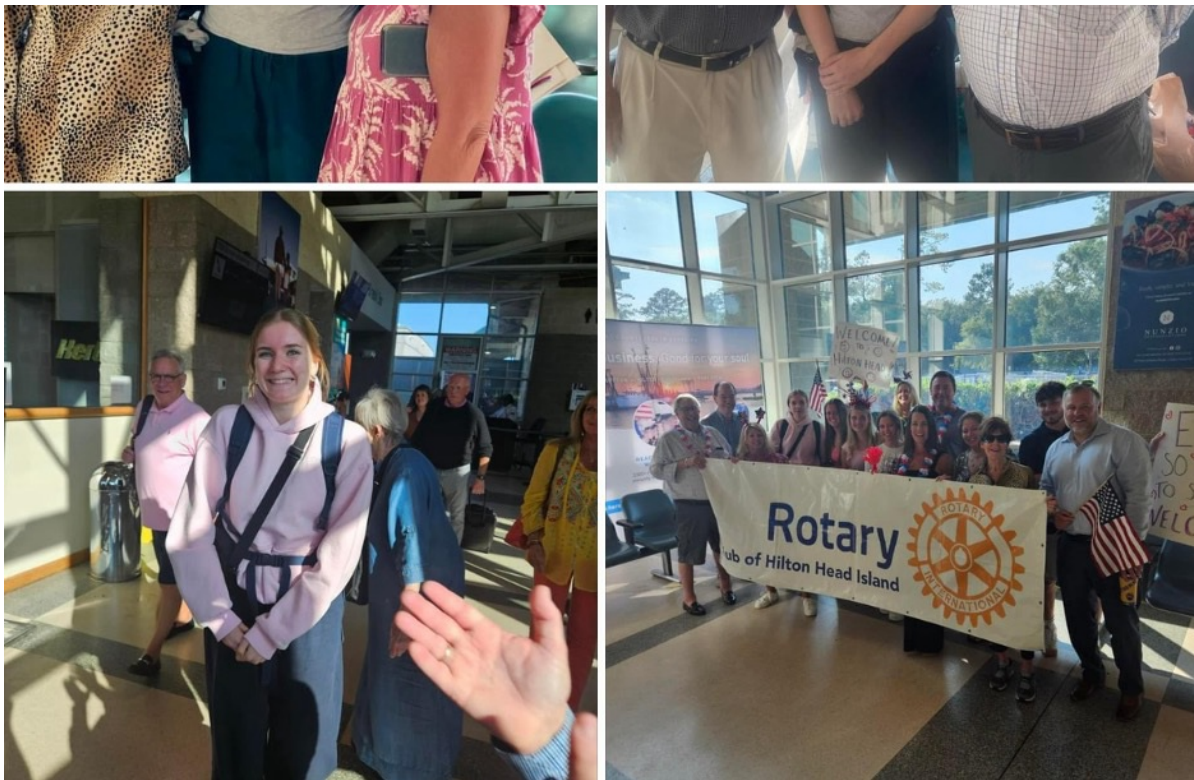


A Warm Welcome to Our New Exchange Student from Germany!

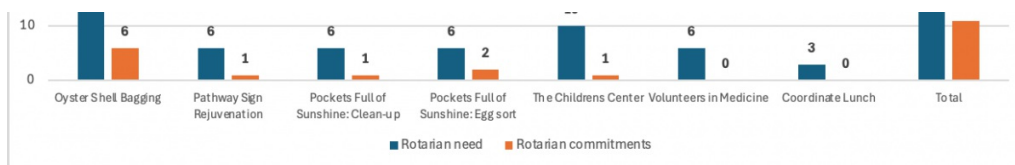
Project 5: Pockets Full of Sunshine
