Rotary leader: Michael Marks

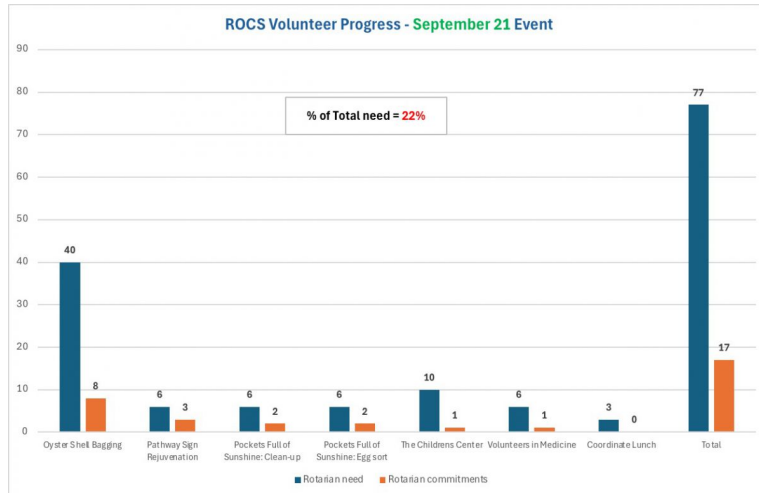
Project 2: Children's Center Beautification

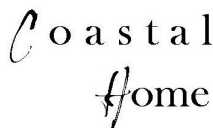
