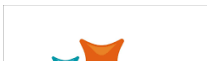

- **In 1975**, Bell Ringing for the Salvation Army began as an annual HHI Rotary Club project.

- **In 1917**, Rotary president Arch Klumph proposed establishing an endowment for the purpose of doing good in the world, which became a precursor to The Rotary Foundation. The Rotary Club of Kansas City, Missouri made the first donation of \$26.50. The Foundation was formally named and a Board of Trustees was created in 1928.

Scope: Remove plants in the Spring Garden, lay down pine straw, refresh the walking path and reapply oyster shells

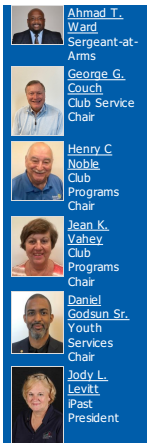
Project 4: Oyster shell bagging - The Outside Foundation

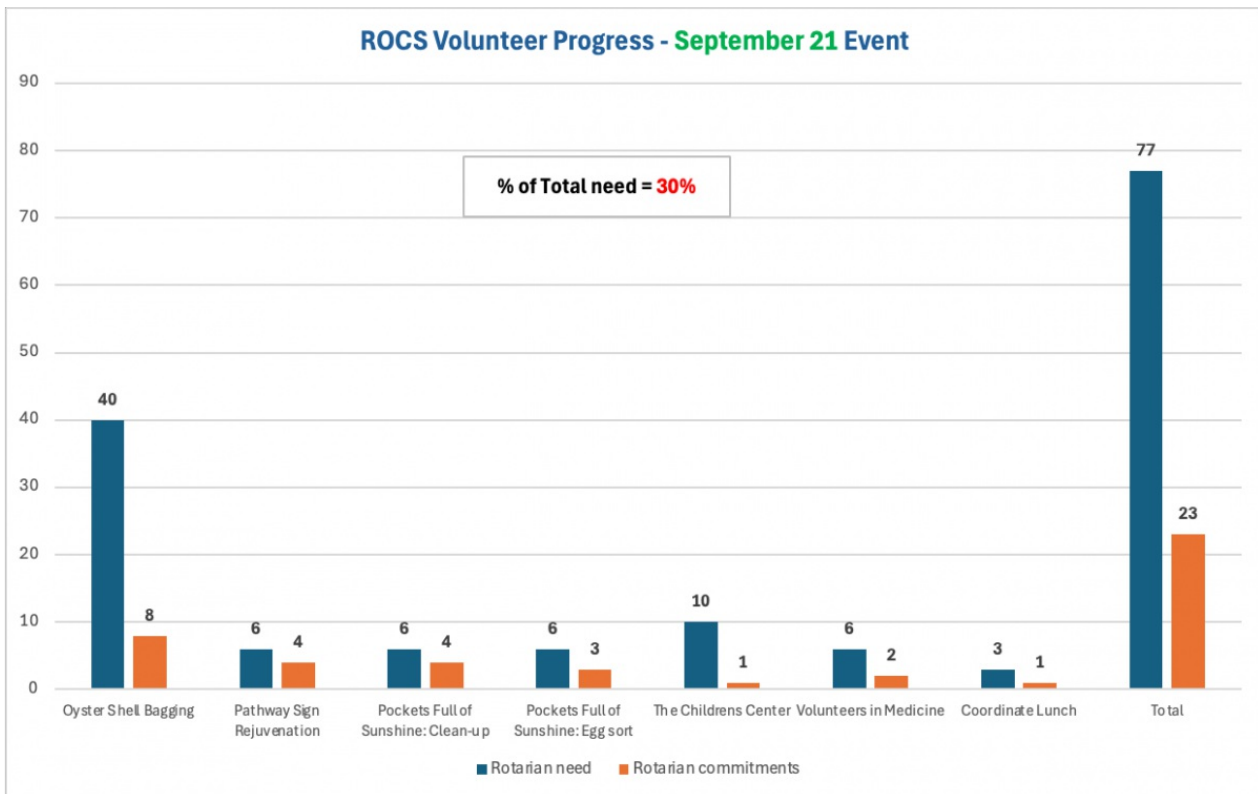
Project 5: Pockets Full of Sunshine

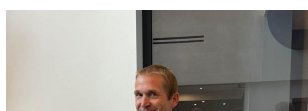

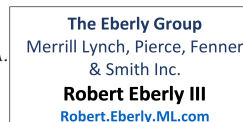
