- · In 1917, Rotary president Arch Klumph proposed establishing an endowment "for the purpose of doing good in the world, †which became a precursor to The Rotary Foundation. The Rotary Club of Kansas City, Missouri made the first donation of \$26.50. The Foundation was formally named and a Board of Trustees was created in 1928.



A Powerful Conversation with Nancy Williams, President of the League of Women Voters of South Carolina


