A possible sailing excursion is being planned for the free time on Saturday afternoon. Stay tuned for more details.

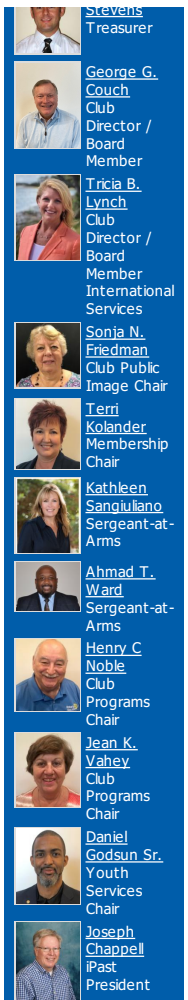
Happy Dollars!

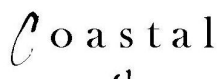
The Four-Way Test
