TRAINING REQUIRED: Saturday 10/29/2022 9am-11am or Friday 10/04/2022 9am-11am

TRAINING LOCATION: Port Royal Golf Club House

10-20 Class Hosts needed for Saturday 11/5 & Sunday 11/6 - Volunteer for 1 day or both

Class host duties: Represent Concours d'Elegance 20th Anniversary & Rotary Club of HHI

Class Hosts will be assigned 4-10 cars in a Car Class, Host will be responsible for arrival of your vehicles, instruct drivers where to park on field, ensure safety protocols are followed by each vehicle & driver, if awarded slot in parade or award ceremony escort your vehicle/driver to the parade ground/award stand and ensure all drivers exit parade grounds safely at end of day.

Details: Work 3-4 hours during 8/9-hour shift. Can be split with spouse (if trained)

7am arrive- greet arriving car class you are responsible for- direct driver to location on field- ensure wheels are chocked, emergency brake set and other details (learn in training), get name and cell number of driver/owner so you can be in contact, accompany awarded cars into parade route/award circle (stay with your car/s), assure cars that leave early are exiting correct route through grounds (usually after awards), direct cars to exit route at end of day.

Benefits: enjoy 5-6 hours on site as visitor, lunch Saturday provided by Chick-fil-e, all day volunteer tent with food/snacks/drinks etc. Saturday only enjoy 4pm-7pm after party with free drinks, food & winners celebration. Sunday only enjoy same as Saturday with Serg provided lunch & 4pm-7pm after party provided by Nunzio's with free food and wine bar & winners circle.

Doggie Paddle

What is Doggie Paddle?

A 501(c)3 charitable organization, umbrellaed under the Glenville Rotary Foundation, with a mission to raise funds and awareness for veterans in need of service dogs. Proceeds are used to assist with veteran's service dog expenses (fully or partially cover the cost of a service dog, assistance with vet bills, food and other dog necessities). Veterans request assistance through a simple, online application at www.doggiepaddle.org.

Many people confuse therapy and emotional support dogs with service dogs. There is a huge difference and an exceptional difference in cost. Many veterans are in need of a trained service dog; however, the cost is not covered by many insurance carriers and veterans may not know where to turn to for help. Our goal at Doggie Paddle is to bridge the gap to make sure veterans get the help they need with a service dog, as well as give these special dogs purpose and a forever home.

Who Would Kayak and Bike 4,000 Miles?

United States Army veteran, Jimmy Thomas knows both the benefits and care a service dog can provide; his loyal Golden Retriever named Boots has changed his life forever. In hopes of helping other veterans in need of a service dog, Jimmy sets off on a one of a kind journey to get our country's attention by paddling his kayak from Upstate New York to Key West, and returning to New York by bicycle. At 61 years old, Jimmy is in great shape with exhilarating, long journeys under his belt, including a 3,500 cross-country bike trip in 2019 from Oregon to Albany and paddling a canoe the entire 444-mile length of the Susquehanna River from Cooperstown to Maryland. Jimmy is no underdog, he is ready.

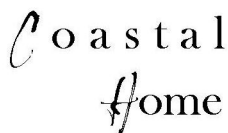
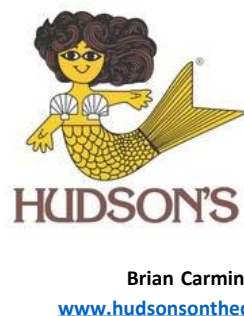
