- In 1973, the Hilton Head Island Rotary Club partnered with the community for funding and purchased the first ambulance for the newly established Island Rescue Squad.

- In 1910, members representing 16 Rotary clubs gathered at the first Rotary Convention in Chicago. They created the National Association of Rotary Clubs of America, adopted a constitution and bylaws for the organization, and elected a board of directors. Rotary clubs remain autonomous but share core values as members of the association.


