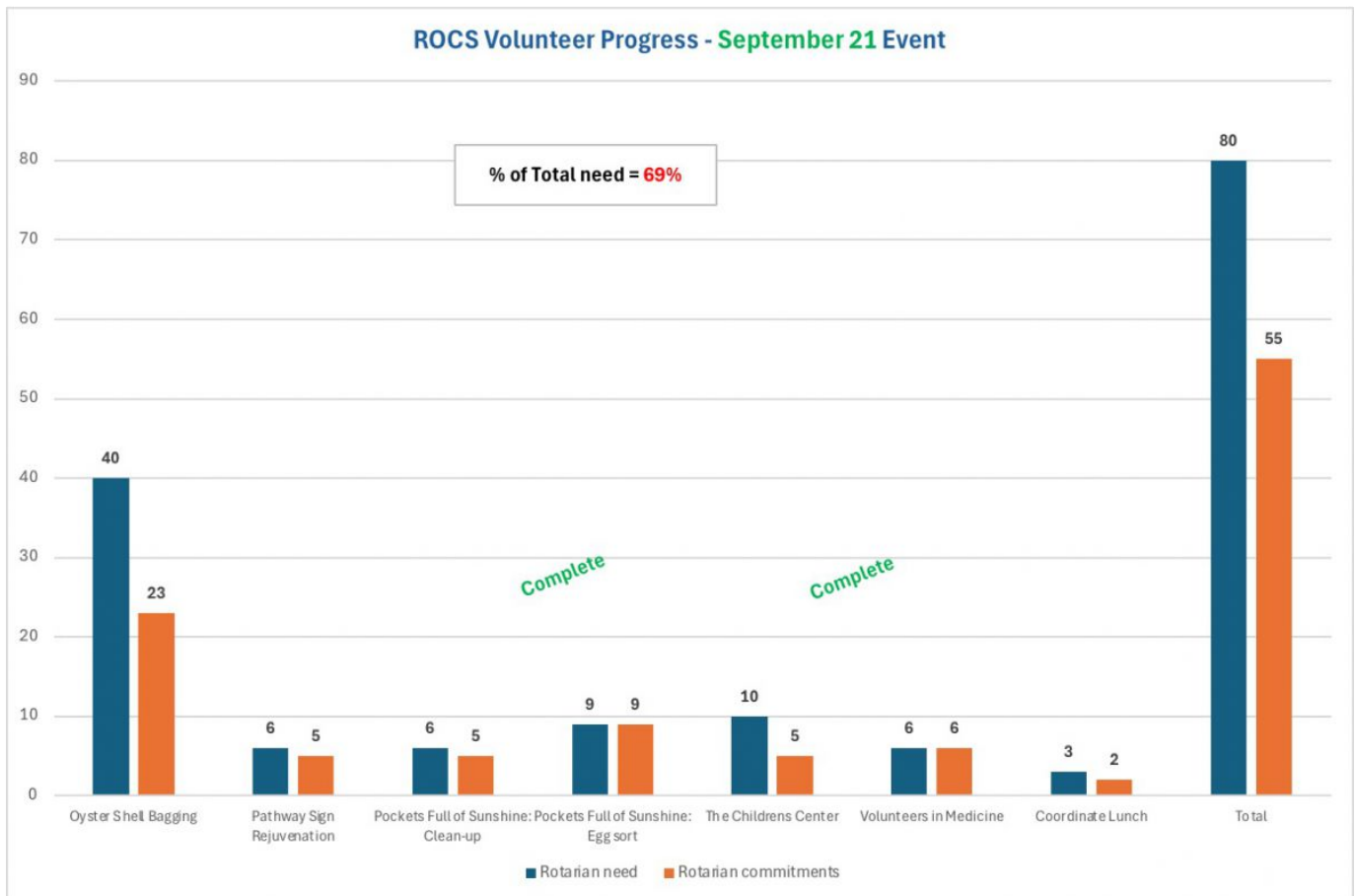
Project 4: Oyster shell bagging - The Outside Foundation

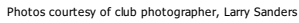
