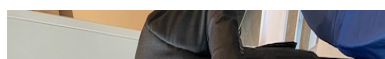
Lowcountry Environmental Club - Update

At the February 21 meeting, Amber Kuehn, President of the Lowcountry Environmental Club, gave us an update on the club's activities:

1. The Lowcountry Environmental Club raised \$13,000 for Maui relief efforts.
2. The Club is working with Brian Julius on a Speaking Book focused on the lowcountry environment. The book will be distributed locally.
3. Quench Buggy: This initiative will provide a wagon to be used at festivals and events to provide water to participants. The objective is to reduce the use of plastic water bottles. Event goers will be encouraged to refill their reusable water bottles with water from the Quench Buggy.

Amber will continue to give us updates on the important work this impact club is doing!

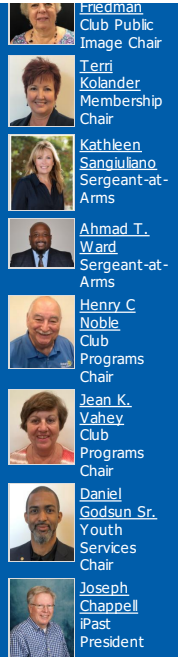
