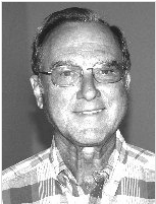

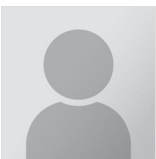

MOW Pets News Coverage on WACH FOX 10.3.22

Columbia, S.C (WACH) — One Midlands girl is making an impact in the lives of seniors and their pets, by raising money for Meals On Wheels.

"Pretty much my whole life I've been rescuing animals. Every animal we have is a rescue animal so I knew I wanted to help animals"

9-year-old Emma Coleman says she's always wanted to help animals and that passion led her to raise four hundred dollars and donate it to the Spring Valley Rotary Cub so they could bring it to the Meals on Wheels program.

Director of Development for Meals On Wheels, Beth Struble, says their clients are isolated or homebound senior citizens for whom having a pet is important to their every day lives.

And the need is real.

"A group of volunteers noticed our Meals on Wheels clients were sharing their hot meals they received everyday with their pets," Struble said.

When 9-year-old Emma Coleman heard about that, she jumped at the opportunity to raise money.

"It made me very happy because I knew that I would be helping cats and dogs and I knew I'd also help their owners a lot because they wouldn't have to share their own food they just received with their animals".

Struble says pets are sometimes the only interaction these seniors get with another life.

"We know the importance of having a pet it's what gets them out of bed in the morning and what keeps them mentally well," Struble said.

Meals On Wheels provides meals for 600 seniors in Richland County and delivers food to around 80 pets every month through the Pet Pals program.

The Spring Valley Rotary Club donates regularly, but the president of the Spring Valley Rotary Club, Dr. Peter Stahl, says this initiative was extra special.

"Emma collecting the money she collected and donating it to the club for this purpose was a whole next level of volunteerism," Dr. Stahl said.

Emma says you don't have to be big to make a big difference.
