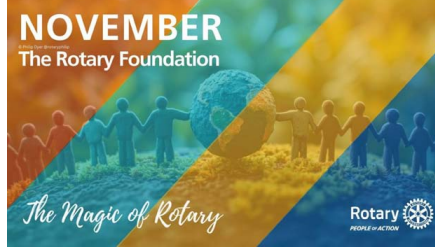

Congratulations to Roland Corning for reaching the Paul Harris +4 Award level. He was recognized at our meeting on October 31.



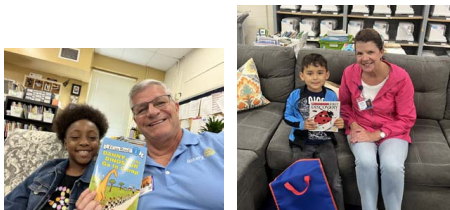
Rotary Readers at Lonnie B. Nelson Elementary School
