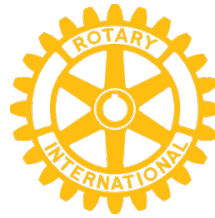

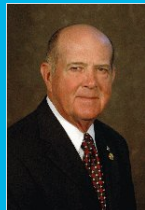

Transportation Penny Tax Program Update

Our speaker will provide an update on the impact of the Transportation Penny Tax Program, a 1 percent sales tax passed by voters in 2012 that funds important projects and public transit throughout Richland County. This presentation is designed to better inform citizens and organizations on how the "Penny" has been utilized to address needs and move Richland County forward.

The Department of Public Works consistently provides a broad range of services and infrastructure to help ensure safe and desirable communities for the people of Richland County. Areas of responsibility include engineering, surveying, GIS, floodplain management, stormwater quality, roads and drainage maintenance, solid waste and recycling, special services, and its administration. The department manages over 600 miles of paved roads, 225 miles of unpaved roads and 92,000 solid waste pickups.

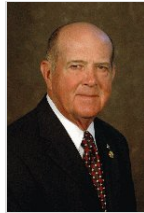
