This year we are hosting one inbound student, Iina Linna from Finland. We already have several interested candidates for OUTBOUND exchanges next year.

We'll each create a "Pop-Up" store and sell Double Good popcorn. Prices for signature bags (5 cups each) start at \$11. The popcorn is ultra-premium, delicious and award-winning.


