
This Week's Program:

Debbie Bender will be introducing Carla H. Angevine MPH, MS, RDN , Director of Community Health/Fit Together, Hartford HealthCare Charlotte Hungerford Hospital

The topic will be the new **Food4Health Program** at Charlotte Hungerford Hospital.

The health of each of our communities is vital to the growth and well-being of our entire region. Unfortunately, Litchfield County's food insecurity rate has grown to a concerning 13.5%-and 19.8% of the region's children are identified as food insecure.

Understanding that nutrition is essential for good health, Charlotte Hungerford Hospital launched Food4Health-a free program that provides northwest Connecticut households equitable access to healthy foods and professional guidance on nutritional meal preparation and eating.
