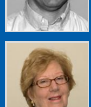

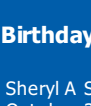

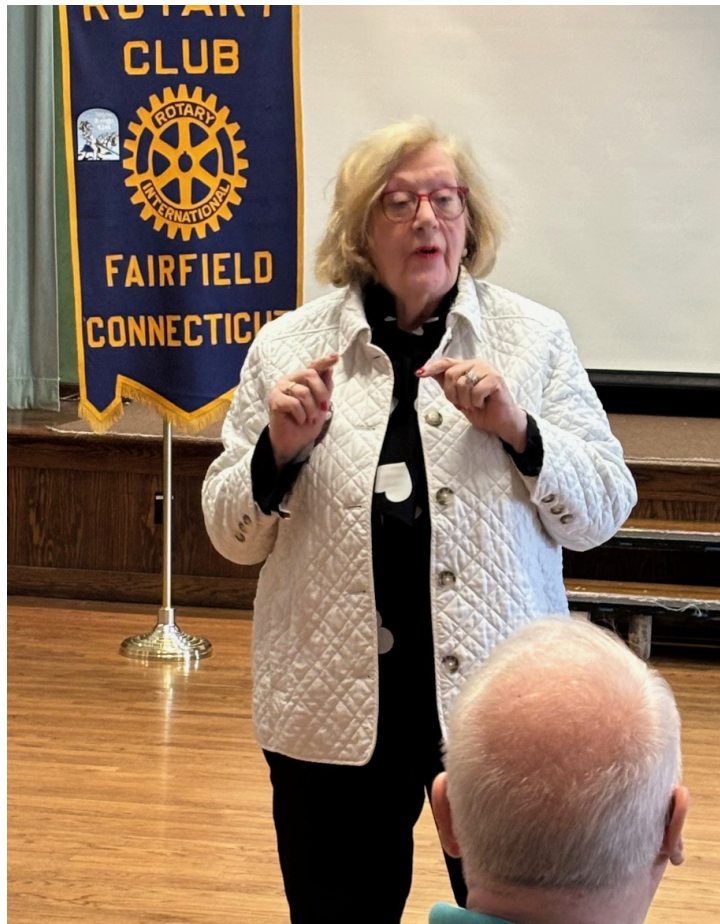
**Bob Vossler:** Signs are here, please get them up ASAP.

...ment. He was glad to keep the budget at 1.8%, but he got some sparky comments and questions.

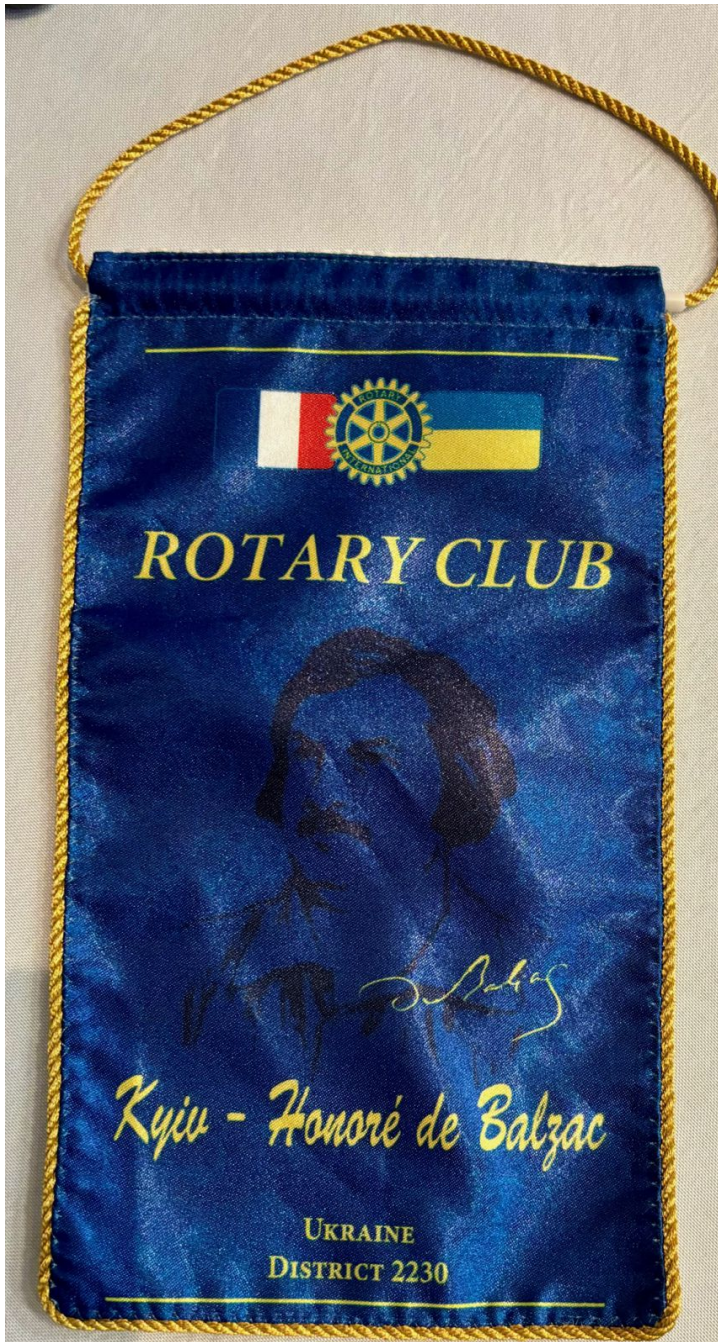
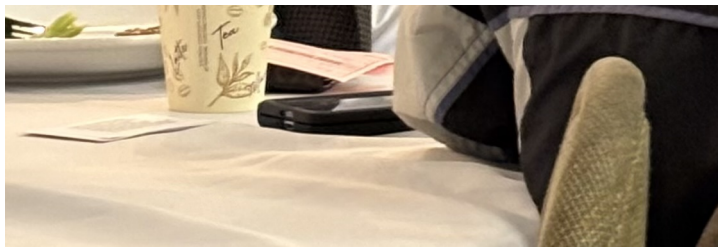


How come the budget doesn't come down?
