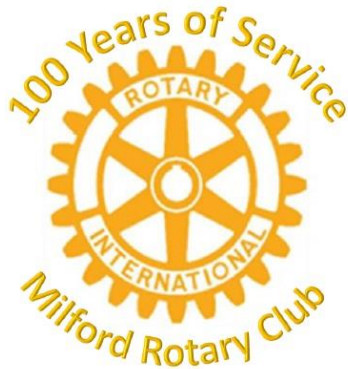


Milford Rotary Chat August 29, 2024
