The funds from this grant were used to purchase equipment and training. This equipment has provided state-of-the-art visual learning opportunities for the deaf community.

We may hear about the important impact Rotary International funding has had in countries far away, but the donations provided to the Foundation also have the power to make a difference to our neighbors. Presidents Michael and Linda have been busy fulfilling the required learning to

qualify to apply for grants, so keep your eyes and hearts open to the possibilities.
