Saving Lives of Moms and Babies in Philippines through Training Health Providers

Two volunteers under the banner of Rotary Club of Taree head off to the Philippines in August 2024 to provide Training in Obstetric Emergencies: Dr Grace Maano (Fellow of Australian College of Rural Remote Medicine) and Aisling Carroll (Registered Midwife). The mission was accomplished with a total of 70 Maternity Health Providers trained - hopefully saving the lives of moms and babies in the event of emergencies during childbirth in the Philippines!

Part 1: August 24, 2024 - Training in Obstetric Emergencies was conducted in the town of Tanay, province of Rizal which is about 2 hours drive from Manila. The training was co-sponsored by the local Rotary club of Midtown Diliman and coordinated through the Local Government Health Unit. 15 Participants attended with majority, if not all, rating the post workshop survey at 5/5 in improving their skills and confidence in managing emergencies at childbirth.







Part 2: August 27 & 28, 2024 - Training in Obstetric Emergencies was conducted at Quezon Medical Centre in the city of Lucena, province of Quezon, which is about 3-4 hours' drive from Manila going south. The training was co-sponsored by UP Kalilayan Alumni Association (UPKAA), Philippine American Medical Association of Georgia (PAMAG-USA) in cooperation with the local Quezon Provincial Health Office. The 2-day training was attended by 2 groups - day 1 was attended by 26 maternity staff (mostly midwives and some nurses) from the local hospitals under the Provincial health office. Day 2 was attended by 29 midwives from the various Rural Health units and lying all around the province.
